Board Meeting Notes:

Reimburse Al Woodhull up to \$200 for the rent of a port-a-potty for Field Day; Aaron motion, Erika 2nd; unanimous.

Nominate Brad Councilman to be activities planner/coordinator (different from our Events Coordinator), ie. for things similar to barbecue at Sugarloaf, meeting at Tom's Hotdogs, Denny's Thursday lunch, etc.; Aaron motion, Dick 2nd; unanimous

Discussion regarding our storage issue: We need to vacate the storage unit that FRCOG has been allowing us to share with them but renting a unit on our own is cost prohibitive. There is a possibility of sharing with MRC as we have done in the past, but accessibility could be limited as it is located on the jail grounds. Many of the items in storage could be rented from Taylor Rental as we needed them for events, for less cost of storing our own. The generator and battery, however, need to be available for emergencies, so depending on them being able to be rented at any time is not reasonable. Decision: Chris Myers will try to contact the Franklin County MRC coordinator to discuss possibly sharing some storage space; Al Woodhull will store the generator and battery in his garage; after Field Day before equipment is

returned to storage an informal inventory will be taken to see what we can get rid of; Aaron will try to dispose of the remaining equipment donated by Carter and will pick up the 440 repeater currently being stored in Al's garage and buy it from the club.

Requests for the club to provide radio support for the Greenfield Triathlon and the Franklin County Land Trust D2R2.

Erika received the town license for the use of Poet's Seat during Field Day. Aaron and Al will be emailed copies of it.

There is nothing magical about a rotation of four, if one or two other people want to join the rotation that will make things easier for everyone.

Some other nets have dedicated Net Control Stations who direct the net every week. While this means the dedicated NCS gets a lot of practice, it can lead to chaos if the one and only for some reason does not make it. The big advantage of having a rotation is that there is almost always someone with experience ready to step up if the scheduled operator doesn't show up at 7 p.m.

Also: even if you are not on the schedule, if nobody at all has called up the net, do so yourself. Don't be shy about improvising if you don't remember the protocol -

make it up as you go! There's nothing wrong with that! It's better than no net at all.
